I am ecstatic to share that the construction of the new wing to our school is scheduled to begin in days...not months or weeks, but is now so close we can honestly say...DAYS! The public hearing recently held by the Pocatello Planning and Zoning Commission was the last hurdle, and was unanimously approved as mentioned last week. The projected starting date is June 4th to accommodate our last day of school on June 1st. When the parish Connector is finished the builder will be able to focus solely on the school project! Completion is preliminarily set for early-mid October...so very exciting!

To review...our new wing is housing four state-of-the-art middle school classrooms. Mrs. Kaiser, Mrs. Newhouse and Mrs. Reams will each have a classroom about the size of one of our main school rooms with natural light, great acoustics, heating and air conditioning, built in storage units, upgraded technology, and plenty of comfortable room for students to learn. Students will have their lockers located in the spacious hall and quad gathering area, with accessibility to the main school for music and computer room. The wing also will have two offices...a real business office for Robin Johns (currently in the library) and a multipurpose, quiet meeting room.

This is the first permanent building added to the school campus since the 1950's! It's long overdue and we are extremely grateful to you parents and guardians, Fr. Henry, and the parish community for supporting our great school with a firm commitment to help us spread our academic and Christian vision to all families. God is truly watching over Holy Spirit Catholic School, and I am very pleased you are part of this wonderfulness! Thank you very much!

Hope to see you tonight in St. Anthony Chapel at 6:30pm for the Middle School Music and Drama Program showcasing our strings orchestra and choir, and a very special play production.

HOLY SPIRIT CATHOLIC SCHOOL RECORD OF SERVICE HOURS ______ SCHOOL YEAR

MUST BE SUBMITTED NO LATER THAN JUNE 2, 2018

Each family is required to adhere to the Service Hour Commitment*. This commitment can be fulfilled through service or monetarily. Kindergarten through eighth grade families are required to provide 20 hours of service or \$300 per year; preschool families are required to provide 10 hours of service or \$150 per school year. Of the 20/10 volunteer service hours, at least **5 hours** must be GIVEN TO EITHER the two major fundraisers of the school year, the Dinner/Auction and/or the Crusader Basketball Tournament. Please record your service hours below and return the completed form to the school office <u>prior to May 26, 2018</u>. If you choose not to perform the service hour requirement you will be billed \$300/\$150, or a rate of \$15.00 per hour for each hour not completed.
